FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2014 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB193

Analysis

SB 193 would require all construction contractors to obtain a license through the elimination of the "handyman" exemption. SB 193 also increases the amount of the bond for general, specialty, and mechanical contractors, creates a new category of bonding for residential contractors at \$20,000, requires "handymen" who do work valued under \$10,000 to post a \$5,000 bond, and amends insurance requirements so that any contractor who does work valued at \$2,500 or less is not required to obtain liability and property insurance.

The division does not anticipate any fiscal impact from this legislation. It will likely increase the number of licensees, but any additional workload would be absorbed by existing staff.

While regulations are required to comply with this bill, the impacted regulations are currently being updated so there would be no additional cost.
