Analysis

Under current law, AS 22.35.010 states that the geographic cost of living adjustment for judges and justices is limited to a maximum of 17.5% and applies only to the first \$40,000 of their salary (for a maximum of \$7,000). No other state employees are subject to these restrictions.
House Bill 100 amends the statutory provisions that govern the geographic cost of living adjustments that apply to judges' and justices' salaries so that their geographic cost of living adjustments would be calculated in the same manner as for other court system employees. However, the differential would be applied to \$100,000 of a judge's salary.
This fiscal note reflects the cost of this change.

As is the case with other state employees, some judges currently receive a geographic differential. Unlike other state employees, however, a judge's geographic differential is calculated only upon the first \$40,000 of salary, not the entire salary. Additionally, the geographic differential paid to some judges is substantially lower than the differential paid to other state employees in the same location. For example, second district judges in Kotzeube are paid a 17.5% geographic differential, while other state employees in this community are paid 60%.
