#### A BILL

## FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to crewmember fishing licenses."

### 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- **Section 1.** AS 16.05.480(i) is amended to read:
- (i) Notwithstanding (g) and (h) of this section, a resident or nonresident engaged in commercial fishing who does not hold an entry permit or an interim-use permit may obtain a seven-day crewmember fishing license under this subsection.

  During the period for which the license is valid, a person who holds a seven-day crewmember fishing license may not engage in fishing with a rod and reel while present on a commercial fishing vessel. The fee for a seven-day crewmember fishing license is \$60 [\$30].
