**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1   **"An Act relating to crewmember fishing licenses."**

2   **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3    \* **Section 1.** AS 16.05.480(i) is amended to read:

4                   (i) Notwithstanding (g) and (h) of this section, a resident or nonresident  
5       engaged in commercial fishing who does not hold an entry permit or an interim-use  
6       permit may obtain a seven-day crewmember fishing license under this subsection.  
7       During the period for which the license is valid, a person who holds a seven-day  
8       crewmember fishing license may not engage in fishing with a rod and reel while  
9       present on a commercial fishing vessel. The fee for a seven-day crewmember fishing  
10      license is \$60 [\$30].
