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FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2013 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB142

Analysis

This legislation increases the monthly per pupil statewide residential educational program stipends from the current rate in law to three times the current rate. The statewide residential program per pupil monthly stipend, paid for nine months based on actual count, supports the dormitory costs for Alaska's three approved residential educational programs.

The program also provides for one round trip ticket per student, by the least expensive means, between the student's community of residence and the school if the district expends money for the trip.

This legislation would support the three approved programs at three times the per pupil monthly stipend rate. The monthly stipend rate is per month for a nine month year, based on an actual per student count. Each program has a maximum capacity for reimbursement based on the district's approved application. The three times rate would provide up to:
