# STATE OF ALASKA 2013 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

#### BILL NO. HB 22

#### Analysis

HB 22 extends the termination date of the Board of Marine Pilots through June 30, 2018 and takes effect immediately upon passage. This board will terminate June 30, 2013 under current law. In accordance with AS 08.03.020 the Board of Marine Pilot will have one year to conclude their business affairs after the date of termination. Licensing and program authority transfer to DCCED if the board is terminated.

Personal Services costs include a full-time Marine Pilot Coordinator.

Travel expenses represent transportation and per diem for the seven member board and staff to meeting in accordance with AS 08.62.030.

Services include contractual obligations, support costs, legal and other necessary services.

Commodities include small equipment and business supplies.

The program is required to cover costs with licensing fees under AS 08.01.065, and revenue generated from board fees are anticipated to cover its full operating costs.
