Section 1. Provides for the approval of an “authorizer” as described in sec. 2, to establish a charter school.	Section 1. Provides for an “authorizer,” as described in sec. 3, to approve a charter school in addition to a local school board. Requires the Department of Education and Early Development to establish a charter school application procedure instead of school districts. Limits teachers to one member on the school advisory committee.
Section 2. Requires the Department of Education and Early Development to establish a procedure for approval of authorizers of charter schools. Provides that authorizers may be a governmental entity, a private nonprofit entity, or a postsecondary institution and describes the duties of an authorizer to include approval, monitoring, and other operational duties for a charter school.	Section 2. Adds an appeal procedure for charter school applicants.
Section 3. Replaces the authorizer for the local school board as contractor with the charter school as described in sec. 5.	Section 3. Requires the Department of Education and Early Development to establish a procedure for approval and removal of authorizers of charter schools. Provides that authorizers may be a governmental entity, a private nonprofit entity, or a postsecondary institution and describes the duties of an authorizer to include approval, monitoring, and other operational duties for a charter school. Requires posting of approved authorizers.
Section 4. Requires an authorizer of a charter school to maintain financial records and	Section 4. Provides for the authorizer or the local school board to serve as contractor with

oversee operation of the charter school, among other things.	the charter school as described in sec. 5.
Section 5. Describes the terms required of a contract between an authorizer and a charter school.	Section 5. Requires an authorizer of a charter school or the local school board to operate under a contract with a charter school to maintain financial records and oversee operation of the charter school, among other things. Describes the terms required of a contract between an authorizer and a charter school.
Section 6. Requires the Department of Education and Early Development, in cooperation with an authorizer or local school board, to provide a charter school with an annual budget and modifies the disbursement of state and local aid through the local school district.	Section 6. Requires the Department of Education and Early Development to provide a charter school with an annual budget and modifies the disbursement of state and local aid through the local school district without costs retained by the district and the department, or the authorizer and the department.
Section 7. Limits the applicability of a negotiated or collective bargaining agreement with a school district.	Section 7. No change
Section 8. Authorizes a charter school to hire teachers and other employees outside of a negotiated or collective bargaining agreement.	Section 8. No change
Section 9. Provides for the applicability of the bill to charter school applications for approval or renewal submitted on or after the effective date.	Section 9. No change
