file with the lieutenant governor a photograph and a statement advocating the		
candidacy within 10 days of becoming a candidate. For a special election, the		
photograph and statement shall be filed by a date specified by the lieutenant		
governor. A candidate whose photograph and statement appeared in the primary		
election pamphlet may file a different photograph and statement to appear in the		
general election pamphlet."
