6 "\*\* Sec. 36. AS 15.58.010 is amended to read:

7 Sec. 15.58.010. Election pamphlet. Before each state primary, general, and  
8 special election, and before each state [PRIMARY OR] special runoff election at  
9 which a ballot proposition is scheduled to appear on the ballot, the lieutenant governor  
10 shall prepare, publish, and mail [AT LEAST] one election pamphlet to each household  
11 identified from the official registration list. The pamphlet shall be prepared on a  
12 regional basis as determined by the lieutenant governor.

13 \* Sec. 37. AS 15.58.020(b) is repealed and reenacted to read:

14 (b) Each primary or special election pamphlet must contain the information  
15 specified in (a)(1) of this section for each candidate scheduled to appear on the ballot  
16 and the information specified in (a)(6) of this section for each ballot proposition, as  
17 well as the information specified in (a)(3) - (5), (7), (9), and (12) of this section. If a  
18 ballot proposition is scheduled to appear on a special runoff election ballot, the  
19 election pamphlet must contain the information specified in (a)(3) - (7), (9), and (12)  
20 of this section.

22 (b) An [NO LATER THAN JULY 22 OF A YEAR IN WHICH A STATE  
23 GENERAL ELECTION WILL BE HELD, AN] individual who becomes a candidate  
24 for the office of United States senator, United States representative, governor,

lieutenant governor, state senator, or state representative under AS 15.25.030 or 15.25.180 may file with the lieutenant governor a photograph and a statement advocating the candidacy. For a primary election, the photograph and statement shall be filed with the lieutenant governor not later than the day following the date of the filing deadline for a declaration of candidacy under AS 15.25.040. For the general election, the photograph and statement shall be filed with the lieutenant governor not later than the day following the date of the primary election, except that an [AN] individual who becomes a candidate for the office of United States senator, United States representative, governor, lieutenant governor, state senator, or state representative by party petition filed under AS 15.25.110 may file with the lieutenant governor a photograph and a statement advocating the candidacy within 10 days of becoming a candidate. For a special election, the photograph and statement shall be filed by a date specified by the lieutenant governor. A candidate whose photograph and statement appeared in the primary election pamphlet may file a different photograph and statement to appear in the general election pamphlet."

"\* Sec. 40. AS 15.58.060(a) is amended to read:

(a) Each [GENERAL ELECTION] candidate shall pay to the lieutenant governor at the time of filing material under this chapter the following:

(1) President or Vice-President of the United States, United States senator, United States representative, governor, lieutenant governor, supreme court justice, and court of appeals judge, \$300 each;

(2) superior court judge and district court judge, \$150 each;

(3) state senator and state representative, \$100 each.

(a) Not less than 22 days before each primary or [THE] general election, the

1 lieutenant governor shall mail to each household identified from the official  
2 registration list [EVERY REGISTERED VOTER] one copy of the pamphlet  
3 prepared for the region in which the household is located. The pamphlet for a  
4 special or special runoff election shall be mailed as soon as practicable before the  
5 election [VOTER RESIDES]. Additional pamphlets may be obtained from the  
6 director, the office of the lieutenant governor, and the area election offices.

7 \* Sec. 42. AS 15.58.080 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

8 (c) All information contained in an election pamphlet for a primary, general,  
9 special, or special runoff election shall be published on the division's Internet website  
10 not later than the date the election pamphlet is mailed to registered voters under (a) of  
11 this section."
