FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2013 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB085

Analysis

This bill will allow the DMV to register, but not title, experimental vehicles that are not yet in production in the U.S. These vehicles are required to be registered in the state to operate on Alaska roadways, and there is currently no provision in the statutes to allow this.
Experimental vehicles would be classified as commercial vehicles, and would be registered for a 12-month period. Under this bill, two additional registration renewals would be allowed for a total registration period of 36 months. After testing is complete, the experimental vehicles would be destroyed or removed from the state.
This bill will take effect on July 1, 2013 and has no fiscal impact on the DMV.
