FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2013 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB 38

Analysis

SB 38 extends the termination date of the Medical Board through June 30, 2020 and takes effect immediately upon passage. The board will terminate June 30, 2013 under current law. In accordance with AS 08.03.020 the Medical Board will have one year to conclude their business affairs after the date of termination. Licensing and program authority transfers to DCCED if the board is terminated.

Personal Services costs include 101.0 for a full-time executive secretary of the board and 90.9 for one full-time investigator as per AS 08.64.103.

Travel expenses of 26.5 represent transportation and per diem for the eight member board and staff to meet at least four times a year In accordance with 08.64.085.

Services include 259.9 for contractual obligations, support costs, legal and other necessary services. Commodities include 6.3 for small equipment and business supplies.

The program is required to cover costs with licensing fees under 08.01.065, and revenue generated from board fees are anticipated to cover its full operating costs.
