Dear Representatives Austerman and Stoltze,

On January 23, 2012, the Department of Corrections (DOC) presented its budget overview to the House Finance Committee. During this meeting questions were raised which required follow-up answers.

Representative Austerman asked how Alaska's offender trends compared with national trends. Currently, Alaska offender population is trending nonviolent and our female inmate population is growing. Both of these trends are consistent with those found nationwide. Further, from 2009-2011 Alaska's inmate population increased at a rate of 2.8% per year while nationwide numbers show a slight decrease in inmate populations.

Representative Holmes asked how many inmates were waitlisted last year for treatment programs.

In FY12 only two programs were unable to serve all of the inmates who wanted to participate. Both the Life Success Substance Abuse Treatment Program (LSSAT) and Residential Substance Abuse Treatment Program (RSAT) had waitlists of 171 and 209 respectively.
