#### FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

### STATE OF ALASKA 2013 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

#### BILL NO. CSHB87(FIN)

#### Analysis

This legislation extends the sunset date for the Special Education Service Agency (SESA) from June 30, 2013 to June 30, 2021. Additionally, the uncodified law is amended stating this Act is retroactive to June 30, 2013.

This legislation removes the SESA oversight from the Governor's Council on Disabilities and Special Education and places governance under the Department of Education & Early Development (DEED). SESA provides outreach services to school districts that serve low incidence severely disabled students. [AS 14.30.600 - 660]

This legislation also repeals language in AS 47.80.090(12), which states that one of the Governor's Council on Disabilities and Special Education's responsibilities is to "govern the special education service agency and may hire personnel necessary to operate the agency."

The fiscal note adds one Education Administrator I position for a cost of \$123.3, travel costs related to attending SESA meetings in Anchorage of \$4.0, core services costs of \$8.5, and program support costs of \$2.0. All costs associated with this position are paid from the general fund. This position is necessary in order for DEED to govern SESA as directed in section 1 of this legislation.
