- 6 2012, is amended to read:
- 7 (c) The task force shall, not later than January 15, <u>2015</u> [2013], submit a
- 8 report to the legislature and the Governor. The report must include
- 9 (1) policy options to achieve a comprehensive autism spectrum 10 disorder early diagnosis and treatment program that results in coverage to the greatest
- 11 number of residents in the state;
- 12 (2) recommendations to the legislature and the Governor that include
- draft legislation required to achieve the policy options proposed by the task force;

 (3) an evaluation of the fiscal effect of the policy options proposed by

1	the task force that includes a five-year projection of both public sector and private
2	sector costs and expenditures;
3	(4) an analysis of how the implementation of P.L. 111-148 (Patien
4	Protection and Affordable Care Act) is expected to affect the options
5	recommendations, and fiscal evaluations of the task force.
