Analysis

This bill has no fiscal impact on the Office of Children's Services. Section 1 requires the Office of Children's Services, within 30 days after removing a child, to exercise due diligence to identify, locate and notify noncustodial parents, adult family members and appropriate adult family friends of the removal. If circumstances prevent the department from completing due diligence, the department shall complete the search as soon as possible. OCS already adheres to most of these notification requirements. Federal 42 U.S.C 671(a)(29) requires OCS to notify noncustodial parents and adult family members of the right to request placement. OCS policy requires notifying all identified relatives. The requirement to also notice "appropriate adult family friends" is a new mandate; however it is not new practice for OCS. "Adult family friends" have been considered for possible placement of a child since 2005. HB 54 also requires an OCS supervisor to certify in writing that due diligence has been exercised. This requirement to verify what is currently being done verbally is new. Section 2 adds the due diligence required under Section 1 and specifies that a family friend considered for placement must be an adult. This section would not have an impact on current practice.
