FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to self-defense in any place where a person has a right to be." 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA: 3 * Section 1. AS 11.81.335(b) is amended to read: 4 (b) A person may not use deadly force under this section if the person knows 5 that, with complete personal safety and with complete safety as to others being 6 defended, the person can avoid the necessity of using deadly force by leaving the area 7 of the encounter, except there is no duty to leave the area if the person is 8 (1) on premises 9 (A) that the person owns or leases; 10 (B) where the person resides, temporarily or permanently; or 11 (C) as a guest or express or implied agent of the owner, lessor, 12

employment or a person assisting a peace officer under AS 11.81.380;

(2) a peace officer acting within the scope and authority of the officer's
