STATE OF ALASKA 2013 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB17

Analysis

This legislation extends the sunset date for the Special Education Service Agency (SESA) from June 30, 2013 to June 30, 2021. Additionally, the uncodified law is amended stating this Act is retroactive to June 30, 2013.

SESA is governed by the Governor's Council on Disabilities and Special Education. It provides outreach services to school districts that serve low incidence severely disabled students. [AS 14.30.600 - 660]
