This bill requires a person operating a motor vehicle on a roadway to drive in the right lane of the roadway except when passing another vehicle, preparing for a left turn, or being directed otherwise, and prohibits a person operating a motor vehicle from impeding or blocking an overtaking vehicle in the left lane. The bill also provides for a fine of at least \$100 for a person who violates these provisions.			
This bill would have no fiscal impact on the Department of Public Safety's Division of Alaska State Troopers.
