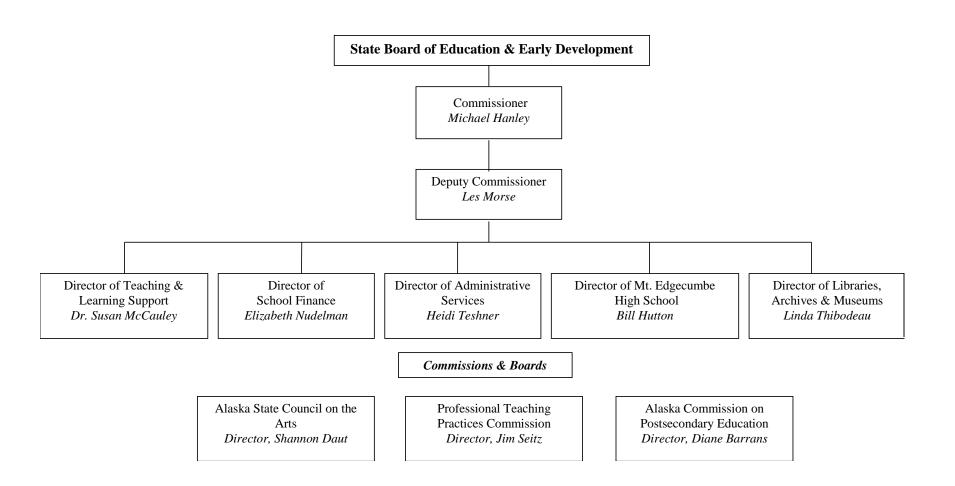

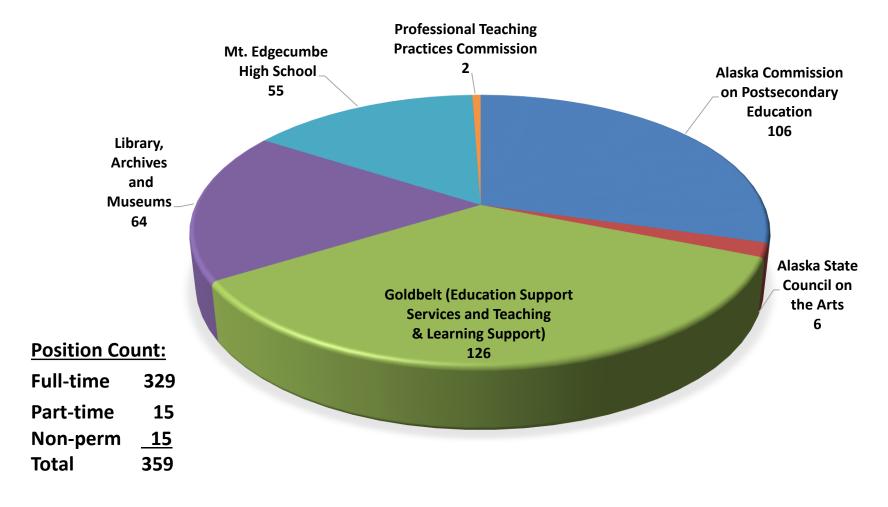
### Mission

#### **Core Services**

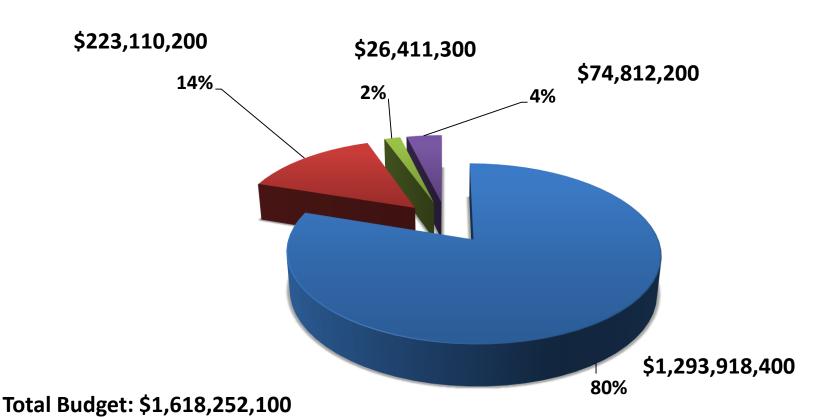
- **1. Public School Funding** Ensure funding is appropriately distributed to recipients based on legislative appropriations and by Statute.

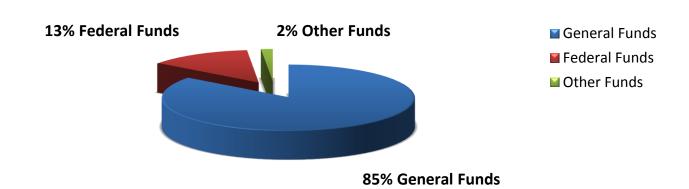




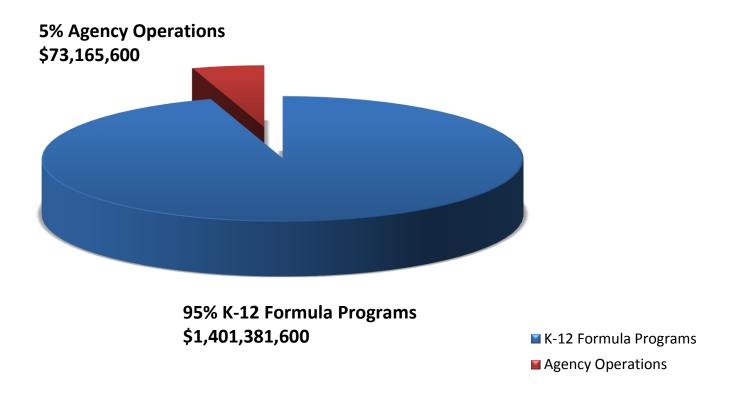

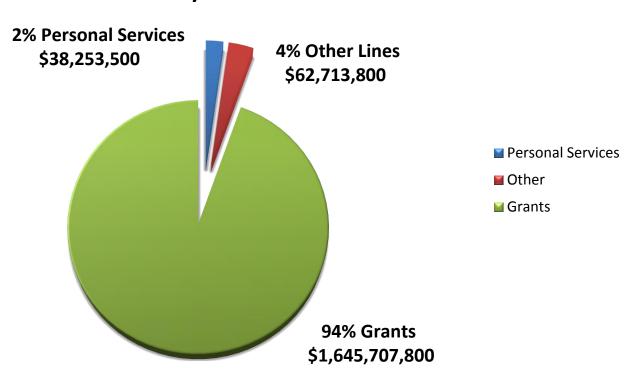
### FY2016 Governor Amended Budget By Fund Source

### All Fund Sources by Line Item



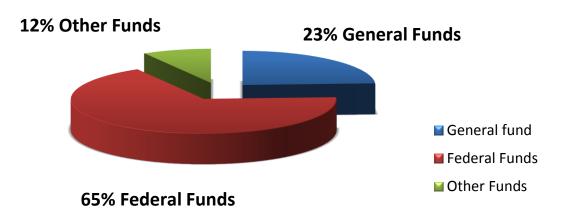
