

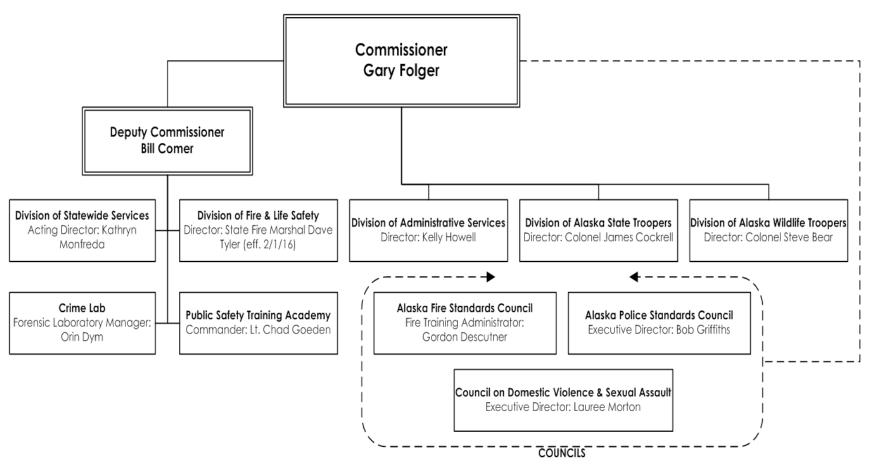

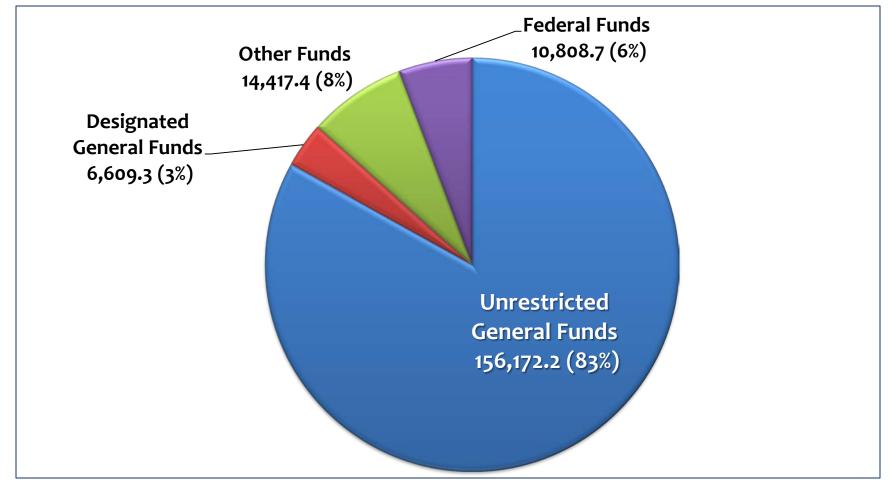

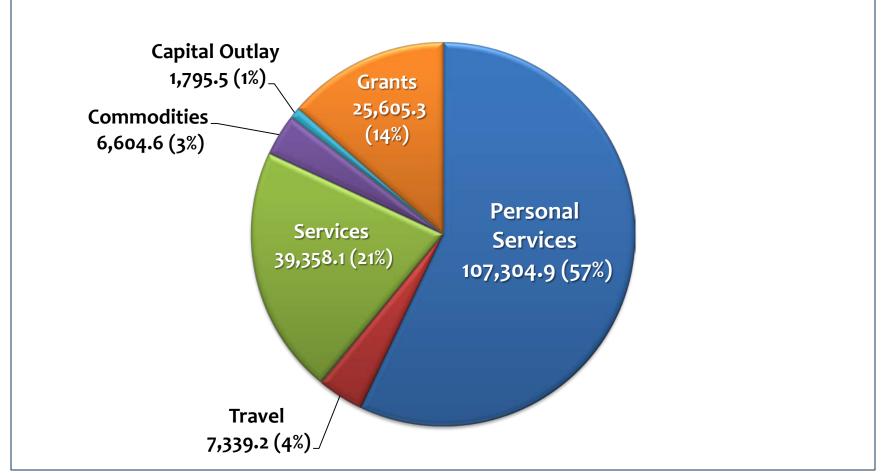

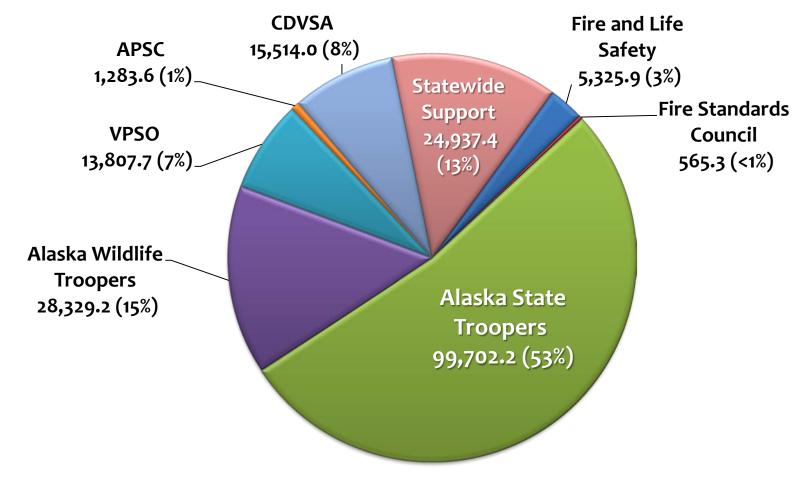
FY2017 Operating Budget By Fund Source



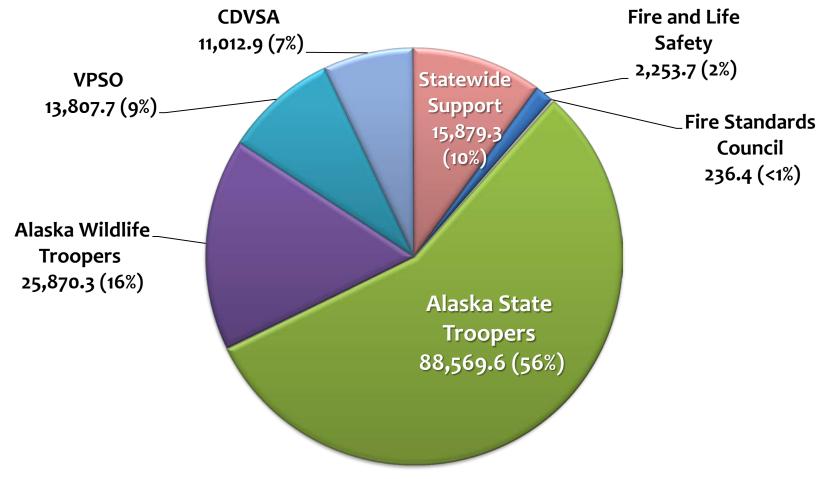
FY2017 Operating Budget By Line Item





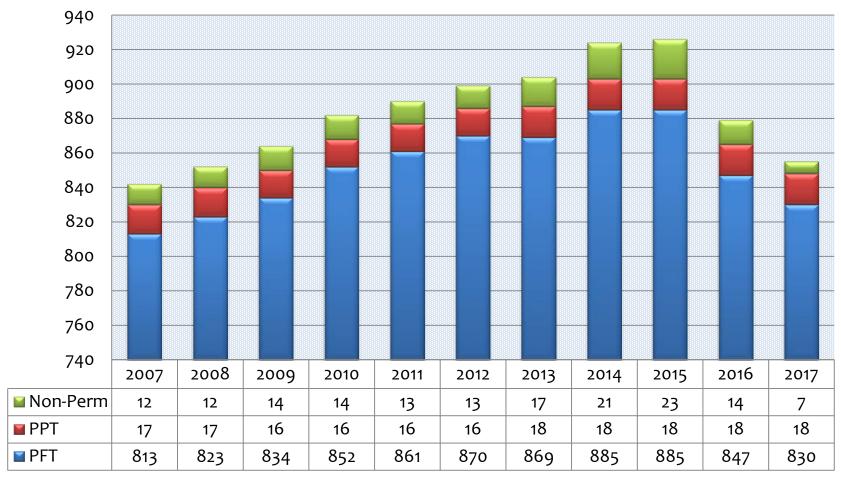

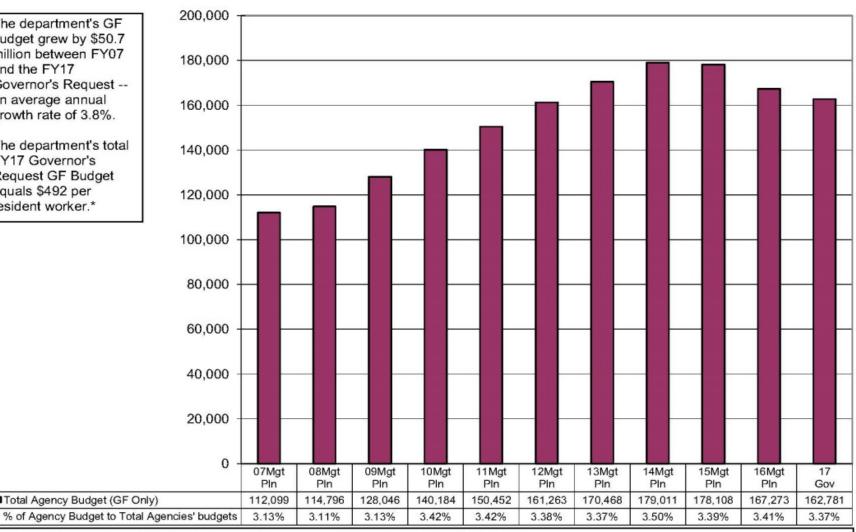

Department of Public Safety's Share of Total Agency Operations (GF Only) (\$ Thousands)

The department's GF budget grew by \$50.7 million between FY07 and the FY17 Governor's Request -an average annual growth rate of 3.8%.

The department's total FY17 Governor's Request GF Budget equals \$492 per resident worker.*

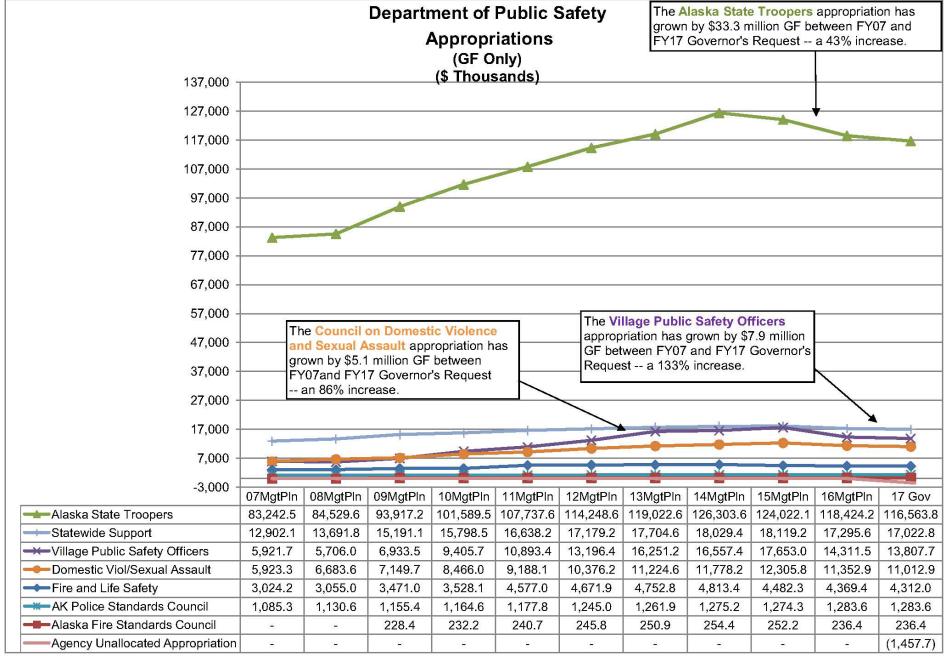

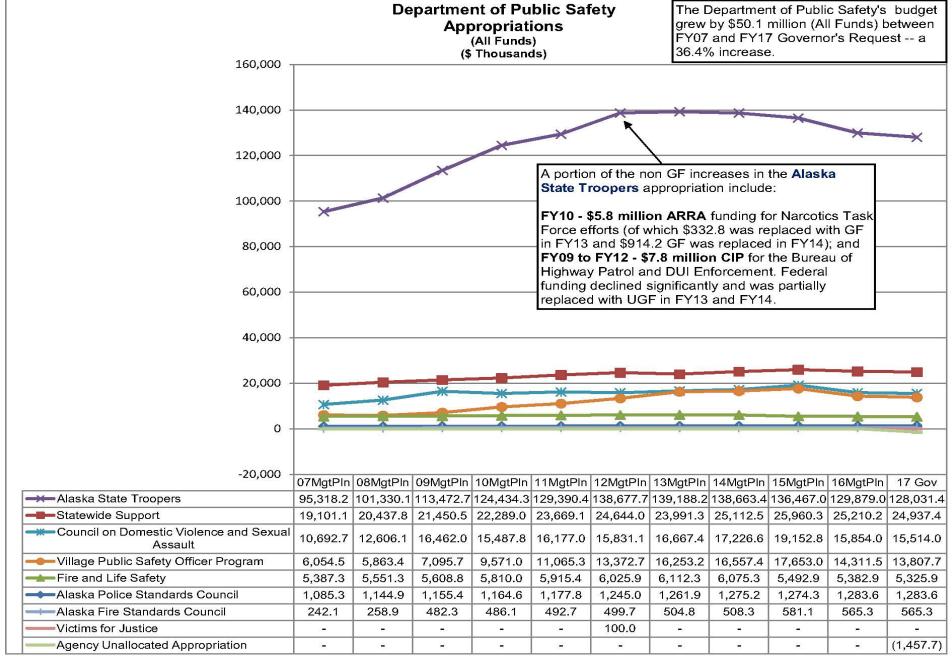
