FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2015 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB 29

Analysis

SB29 proposes to add a seat to the State Medical Board to be filled by a mobile intensive care paramedic.

If the bill passes, the following expenses will be incurred: Travel: \$7.0 (one additional board member to travel to four board meetings per year)

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by receipt supported services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Licensing fees for each program are set per AS 08.01.06,5 so the revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs.
