**FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS**

**STATE OF ALASKA  
2015 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**

**BILL NO. SB 14**

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**Analysis**

SB14 proposes to add a seat to the State Medical Board to be filled by a mobile intensive care paramedic, updates health care provider definitions related to medical review organizations, changes civil liability immunity for emergency use of automated external defibrillators, and establishes effective dates for the different sections.

If the bill passes, the following expenses will be incurred:

Travel: \$7.0 (one additional board member to travel to four board meetings per year)

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by receipt supported services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Licensing fees for each program are set per AS 08.01.065 so the revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs.
