Analysis

This bill establishes a regulatory and licensing process for marijuana production and related businesses. This responsibility falls within the Department of Commerce.

Section 1: AS 03.05.011 adds a new subsection requiring the Commissioner of Environmental Conservation to inspect and certfiy marijuana testing facilities.

No regulatory or licensing process outlined in this bill involves the Division of Agriculture.
