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Analysis

HB 287 would amend AS 44.23, the powers and duties of the attorney general, to add a new provision to prohibit appointment of the attorney general as a member of a state board or commission and or to serve or be a member of the governing body of a state public corporation or other state entity that has a governing body.

In addition, the bill would amend statutes establishing the board of governors of the regional resources development authorities (AS 30.13.020), the Adak Reuse Authority (AS 30.17,020), the Alaska Gasline Development Authority (AS 31.25.020), and the Board of Trustees of the Alaska Permanent Fund Corporation (AS 37.13.050) to prohibit the appointment of the attorney general to serve as a member on those executive boards.

HB 287 would amend the State Personnel Act (AS 39.25) provision on the appointment authorities for all officers and employees of the executive branch (AS 39.25.020) to limit the general appointment powers of AS 39.20.020(a) to exclude appointment of the attorney general to a state board or commission or to a governing body of a state public corporation or other entity that has a governing board. Furthermore, an attorney, other than the attorney general, would serve as a member of the Multistate Tax Compact Advisory Committee (AS 43.19.040).

The bill contains provisions in uncodified law related to legislative findings.

The Department of Law expects no fiscal impact to the department should this bill become law.

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
