VPSOs partnering with rural Alaskans to improve safety and quality of life.


















Appropriation Funding Breakdown








FY16 Original Grant Appropriation




FY16 Final Support Appropriation






FY16 Indirect

Indirect Rates Issue














Turnover since 2006



The overall turnover of VPSOs in the program has trended up since 2006. In 2006, the program ended the year with 7 more VPSOs in communities than we began the year and since 2006, the program has steadily increased in the number of VPSOs in communities.

Of the 9 VPSO that have graduated ALET, only two have left the program and these VPSOs have been hired by other Alaska law enforcement departments.
