Governor's Amended Budget presented to House Finance Sub-Committee

Operating Amendments

Allocation of Unallocated Reductions (\$339.1)

- Administrative Services (\$33.5)
 - Reduce sole administrative support position in Anchorage from an Administrative Officer to an Administrative Assistant, resulting in less training and direct assistance for Anchorage staff.
- Community and Regional Affairs (\$111.3)
 - Delete one Grant Administrator position, leaving ten grants staff to administer a portfolio of over \$1.6 billion and nearly 1,300 individual grants.
- Economic Development (\$37.6)
 - Curtail industry research and promotional activities. At least one smallscale research or development project will not occur.
- Alaska Energy Authority (\$156.7)
 - Further reduce utility operator training, community energy management assistance, and circuit rider facility maintenance support.

Operating Amendments (continued)

Tourism Marketing

- Transfer general funds from other funding lines to grants
- Total to be granted is \$4,528.9 UGF
- Delete \$3,575.0 statutory designated program receipt authority and 2 full-time positions
- Grant to named recipient administered under AS 37.05.316
- Tourism marketing activities:
 - Instate, national and international tourism marketing
 - Collection of visitor statistics
 - Cooperative marketing with Canada
 - Support for Alaska Tourism Marketing Board

Alaska Energy Authority (\$6,368.5 Multiple Fund Sources)

- Reprioritization of statewide energy programs
- Discontinuation of the Statewide Development, Alternative Energy and Energy Efficiency component
