Representatives Nageak and Talerico;

During the hearing in your committee on HB 100, "An Act establishing a credit against the net income tax for an in-state processing facility that manufactures urea or ammonia" on Wednesday, March 11<sup>th</sup>, Representative Paul Seaton posed a question about acceptable levels of carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) in the gas that feeds our plant.

Our normal CO<sub>2</sub> gas composition during past operation was about 0.1 - 0.2%. However, we should be able to operate with as high as 3% CO<sub>2</sub> without significant impact.

I hope this responds to Representative Seaton's question, and I trust you will distribute my response to other committee members.
