BILL NO. HB 149

Analysis

HB149 allows a Native corporation organized before July 1, 1989, under 43 U.S.C. 1601 (Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act) to amend its articles of incorporation to reduce the quorum necessary to hold a meeting to one-third of the outstanding shares entitled to vote. The reduced quorum may not be used to adopt other amendments or resolutions.

The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
