Board of Regents Composition
Version N

Section 1:

AS 14.40.130(a). Repeals and Reenacts
Composition of the Board of Regents

Defines the Board of Regents by requiring:

1. One resident of Fairbanks North Star Borough
2. One resident of Municipality of Anchorage
3. One resident of Matanuska-Susitna Borough
4. One resident of Kenai Peninsula Borough
5. One resident of City and Borough of Juneau
6. One resident of a community that is not described in (1) through (5) of this subsection and is not connected by road or rail to Anchorage or Fairbanks;
7. One student regent.
8. Four at large members that are Alaskan Residents.

Section 2:

AS 14.40.130. Adds new subsections
Regents Qualifications and Board Membership

Regents must be a resident of region for at least one year prior to appointment.

Membership terminates if a Regent fails to maintain residency in region.

Governor has 60 days to appoint a successor after a position on the board becomes vacant.

Section 3:

Uncodified law. TRANSITION

Regents currently serving on the board will finish their terms and as vacancies arise the governor shall make appointments that fulfill the residency requirements of this act.
