# **A RESOLUTION**

1 Designating January 25 - 31, 2015, as Alaska School Choice Week.

# 2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- WHEREAS every student in the state should have access to an effective education;
  and
- WHEREAS citizens across the state agree that continuing to improve the quality of education in the state is an issue of importance to our state's leaders; and
- WHEREAS the state recognizes the critical role that an effective and accountable system of education plays in preparing all children in the state to be successful adults; and
- WHEREAS the state has a multitude of high quality traditional public schools, public charter schools, and nonpublic schools, as well as families who educate their children in the home; and
- WHEREAS the state has many high quality, dedicated teaching professionals in all types of educational environments; and
- WHEREAS it is important for parents in the state to explore and identify the best educational options available to their children; and
- WHEREAS research demonstrates that providing children with multiple educational
