# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- "An Act relating to diagnosis, treatment, and prescription of drugs without a physical examination by a physician; relating to the delivery of services by a licensed professional counselor, marriage and family therapist, psychologist, psychological associate, and social worker by audio, video, or data communications."
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- \* **Section 1.** AS 08.29.400 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- 7 (b) The board may not impose disciplinary sanctions on a licensee for the 8 evaluation, diagnosis, or treatment of a person through audio, video, or data 9 communications when physically separated from the person if
- 10 (1) the licensee or another licensed health care provider is available to 11 provide follow-up care; and
- 12 (2) the licensee requests that the person consent to sending a copy of 13 all records of the encounter to a primary care provider if the licensee is not the 14 person's primary care provider and, if the person consents, the licensee sends the
