I have been a frequent visitor to Alaska over the past 23 years, have family in Valdez and have been a supporter and contributor to KCHU Terminal Radio

during that time period as well as my local Public radio station here in Pennsylvania.

KCHU is truly unique as it serves the largest geographic region of any Public Radio station in the entire United States. While Alaska is truly unique also,

The remote areas that this public radio station serves cover places that have no internet and spotty TV service.

If you haven't been there, once you get past the 11 mile marker from Valdez to the 70 mile marker, there is no phone service but you can hear the news on KCHU.

From mile marker 70 to 90 there is spotty coverage. This station plays a key part not only in their immediate community but in a large geographical area around it.

Cutting funding from public radio and broadcasting is foolish when you consider YOUR constituents that are listeners and may be affected by it.

I urge you to rethink your understanding. This is Public Radio, the key word being Public... and those people are voters.
