This legislation amends Alaska's Little Davis Bacon Act (AS 36.05.005) to increase the threshold of coverage for public construction contracts from \$25.0 to \$75.0. The bill establishes that contracts entered on or after the effective date will be subject to the new monetary threshold.		
In FY2015, the certified payroll filing fee revenue associated with public construction projects valued at less than \$75.0 was approximately \$125.0. This legislation would result in the loss of this revenue.
