FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. HB 289

Analysis

HB289 adds two seats to the Board of Barbers and Hairdressers: one seat to be filled by a nail technician, and one seat to be filled by any type of licensee. This legislation also removes one of two barber seats.

If this legislation passes, the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing will incur expenses for travel costs for one additional board member to attend three board meetings per year.

If the bill passes the following expenses will be incurred:

Travel: \$4.5

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065 so the total amount of revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs.
