A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to an electronic visit verification system for providers of personal care services or home and community-based services under the state medical assistance program."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* **Section 1.** AS 47.07 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 47.07.047. Electronic visit verification system. (a) The department shall contract with a vendor to implement an electronic visit verification system that requires medical assistance providers to verify visits conducted to provide personal care services in a recipient's home or other approved setting or to provide home and community-based services to a recipient. The electronic visit verification system must

- (1) allow providers to document and transmit information to the vendor in real-time to the extent feasible;
- (2) be integrated, to the extent feasible, with electronic visit verification systems currently used by providers;

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- (3) allow a provider to electronically document the
 - (A) provider's name;
 - (B) recipient's name;

services; and

- (C) date and time the provider begins and ends the delivery of
- (D) location of the delivery of services; and
- (4) procedures to notify a provider and the department when a vendor identifies a missed appointment or a failure to provide scheduled services.
- (b) In this section, "real-time" means concurrent with or within a few minutes of the occurrence of an event.

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
