Dear State of Alaska Legislators,

The North Pacific Fisheries Association would like to express our support for Robert Ruffner as a candidate for the State of Alaska Board of Fisheries. NPFA is a multi gear, multi species commercial fishing organization representing about fifty family fishing operations, mostly based out of Homer. Our members participate in many fisheries throughout the State from Southeast to the Bering Sea.
