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Analysis

The Commercial Fisheries Division intends to utilize existing staff under the Aquaculture Section to administer the program proposed in this legislation. The Private Nonprofit Hatchery Permit Coordinator is the primary person re for evaluating these permit applications. The Department of Fish and Game genetics, pathology, and managemer also contribute to the permit application review process. Permit application review generally takes six months to to complete. The permit fee is established in AS 16.012.010(c) at \$1,000. This fee would also apply to applications	esponsible nt staff one year s for new
salmon private nonprofit hatcheries. That fee is currently \$100. The division anticipates that there will be two to applicants per year for the first two years and then decline to an estimated one permit per year.	three
