A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to marriage solemnization."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * Section 1. AS 25.05.261 is amended by adding new subsections to read:
- 4 (c) Nothing in this section creates or implies a duty on a person authorized to solemnize a marriage under (a)(1) or (3) of this section to
 - (1) solemnize a marriage; or
 - (2) provide services, accommodations, facilities, goods, or privileges for a purpose related to the solemnization, formation, or celebration of a marriage.
 - (d) A person permitted to solemnize a marriage under (a)(1) or (3) of this section is not subject to criminal or civil liability for refusing to solemnize a marriage or refusing to provide services, accommodations, facilities, goods, or privileges for a purpose related to the solemnization, formation, or celebration of a marriage.
 - (e) The state or a municipality may not penalize a person who is permitted to solemnize a marriage under (a)(1) or (3) of this section for refusing to solemnize a marriage or refusing to provide services, accommodations, facilities, goods, or

2	marriage. In this subsection, "penalize" means to take an action affecting a benefit or
3	privilege guaranteed to the person by law, including a tax exemption or state or
4	municipal contract, grant, or license.
