We have cut 5 full time positions from our staff, while trying to keep those cuts from affecting the classroom. I know this is a time of financial uncertainty, but I ask you to reconsider the drastic cuts to public education. Schools across the state are looking to see where they can find savings. But we need to make thoughtful decisions with caution and precision.

Nome Public Schools already partners with many entities to offer quality education and opportunities to our youth.
