While moving 3 of 6 Troopers to Soldotna and closing the Girdwood State Trooper post will certainly save the State a few hundred thousand, it will raise the overall cost of policing dramatically.

Muni of Anchorage wants to put 6 to 9 APD in Girdwood. To patrol 3 miles of improved road at a cost of between \$1.2 and \$1.5 million. Because most crime occurs out on the state highway, APD has said they will have a presence on the state highway. The taxes on my modest house will increase by \$1500 a yr to pay for patroling on a STATE HIGHWAY...The troopers never have spent much time in our town or in their office...they are almost always out on the highway
