FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2016 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB 113

Analysis

SB113 would provide certain immunities to prescribing physicians, manufacturers, and distributors acting in good faith to allow terminally ill patients who have exhausted other available treatments faster access to experimental drugs, without waiting for federal approval. This legislation prohibits disciplinary action against physicians by the State Medical Board for prescribing, dispensing or administering an investigational drug, biological product, or device to terminally ill patients who have considered all other treatment options approved by the FDA. In addition, it prevents hospitals and health facilities from restricting the use of investigational drugs as provided. This legislation establishes immunity for physicians, manufacturers, and distributors in the case of injury or death of a terminally ill patient from the use of an investigational drug, biological product or device, provided informed consent was obtained from the patient and notice of immunity was given in advance. This legislation amends the statute limiting the sale and distribution of new drugs so as not to apply to physicians prescribing or administering investigational drugs under the conditions established in Section 1. The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
