How much do we need?

Food	90 Day Supply	Current Production
Spuds	1200 acres	560 acres
Carrots	50 acres	46
Milk	28M pounds	3.3M pounds
Grains	12,000 acres	200 acres
Red Meat	13M pounds	1.1M pounds
Poultry	9.75M pounds	25K pounds

Economics

- \$3 Billion on food
- 95% imported
- $\$3B \times 25\% = \$750M$
- 2016 Oil Production Revenue ~ \$799M including investments

Multiplier – 2.13

750M adds \$1.6B to economy
