2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 4 (a) A person commits the crime of arson in the third degree if the person
- 5 intentionally damages a motor vehicle
- 6 (1) by starting a fire or causing an explosion while that vehicle is
- 7 located on <u>public</u> [STATE OR MUNICIPAL] land; or
- 8 (2) that is the property of another person by starting a fire or
- 9 causing an explosion while that vehicle is located on private property.
