

## Schedule of Drugs

**VA** – codeine, very small amounts of some of the higher schedule drugs, anabolic steroids

**IVA** – barbitol (sleeping aid), chloral hydrate (sedative), oxazepam - It can treat anxiety, anxiety with depression, and symptoms of alcohol withdrawal. Can cause paranoid or suicidal ideation and impair memory, judgment, and coordination. Combining with other substances, particularly alcohol, can slow breathing and possibly lead to death.

Also includes diethylpropion (treat obesity).

**IIIA** – A variety of controlled substances, some of which are Central nervous system stimulants like benzphetamine and chlorphentermine (Appetite suppressants - Can cause rapid or irregular heartbeat, delirium, panic, psychosis, and heart failure), and some are Central nervous system depressants like amobarbital and secobarbital which are sedatives which can treat trouble falling asleep (insomnia). It can also make patients sleepy before surgery or medical procedures. Can cause paranoid or suicidal ideation and impair memory, judgment, and coordination. Combining with other substances, particularly alcohol, can slow breathing and possibly lead to death.

Also includes hashish, hash oil and tetrahydrocannabinols (principal psychoactive constituent (or cannabinoid) of cannabis).

**IIA** – LSD, meth, cocaine (strong stimulant that gives a short-lived, intense high) and a variety of amphetamines.

**1A** – heroin, opium, hydrocodone, oxycodone, fentanyl (pain patch) - It can treat severe pain. Can cause life-threatening respiratory distress when taken in high doses or when combined with other substances. Also has a high risk of dependency. Also, GHB, date-rape drugs.
