# Analysis

House Bill 70 will amend the legal boundary description for Creamer's Field Waterfowl Refuge to include lands that have either deed restrictions or management rights directing that they be managed as a part of the Refuge until such a time as they can be included in the Refuge's statutory boundary language. The addition of these parcels of land to the Refuge's statutes will not require any additional funding.
