2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 5 (1) a <u>violation</u> [CLASS A MISDEMEANOR], unless any of the
- 6 circumstances described in (2) (4) of this subsection apply;
- 7 (2) a class C felony if the person's driving causes physical injury to
- 8 another person;
- 9 (3) a class B felony if the person's driving causes serious physical
- injury to another person;
- 11 (4) a class A felony if the person's driving causes the death of another
- person.
