

Typically, two or three reviews occur before a plat is ready for signature. DNR conducted 493 survey reviews last year. Under SB 118, an estimated 75 of these (25 surveys) would have been eligible for the AELS review option.

The DNR survey process begins with issuance of survey instructions to the surveyor, whom conducts the survey and submits it to DNR for review. Typically two to three reviews are necessary before the final plat is approved.

DNR's goal is 60 day turn around for survey instructions and plat reviews. For survey instructions we were at 90 days, until a staff member retired in September 2015. Survey instructions backlog is now 7 months. As of January 2015 it was 13, and currently it is 27, 10 of which are for the North Slope Borough municipal entitlements.

Plat review backlog has been a continuing issue, with some taking 15 months to get out. By using teams to catch up, we have reduced the plat review backlog from 71 on January 2015 (15 month turn around max) to currently 54 (10 month turn around max).

We have made several changes to improve the quality of submittals and improve our turn around time.
