- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- 4 * **Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Article 5. Standard Time. 5
- Sec. 44.12.400. Exemption from daylight saving time. The state exempts 6
- itself from observation of advanced time, also known as daylight saving time, during
- 8 the period set under 15 U.S.C. 260a for the advancement of time each calendar year,
- 9 and the entire state shall observe the standard time that is otherwise applicable during
- 10 that period.
- 11 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2017.
