FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2015 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

With the passage of HB 316 in 2014, the Medical Services Review Committee was tasked with creating conversion factors for a fee schedule produced by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for Workers' Compensation medical billings. This bill postpones the effective date of the new fee schedule from July 1, 2015 to December 1, 2015.
There is no fiscal impact to the Department of Labor and Workforce Development anticipated as a result of this legislation.
