I am writing this letter in support of HB 131. Alaska ranks last nationally for requirements to receive a nail technician license. Our state requires a 12 hour theory class that only covers sanitation, while all other states require anywhere from 100 to 700 hours of education plus a state board exam (which currently we do not have). This is a public health and safety issue, we are misleading the public. The general public has no idea that in most cases the licensee under current standards has had no formal training on the service they are providing for a fee. This regulatory change would also allow Alaska nail technicians to have reciprocity with other states which they currently do not have.
